



EASTERN SECTION WEEKEND HILL LEADER DUTIES

SATURDAY AND SUNDAY DUTIES:

- A.** HILL LEADER SHOULD ARRIVE AT THE BULL PEN NO LATER THAN 8:00 A.M. ON WEEKENDS.
- B.** ASSIGN FIRST AID ROOM DUTY (ON THE HOUR TO BE STAFFED BY AUXILIARIES & CANDIDATES, if available)
- C.** ASSIGN THE FIRST PERSON ON AID-ROOM DUTY TO CHECK AND ORGANIZE FIRST AID SUPPLIES IN AID ROOMS.
- D.** ASSIGN PEAK DUTY (ON THE HOUR FOR ONE HOUR SHIFTS FROM 10 a.m. UNTIL 4:00 p.m.). ASSIGN "BUBBLE" DUTY (ON THE HALF HOUR FOR ONE HOUR SHIFTS FROM 9:30 a.m until 3:30 p.m). BE SURE TO TRANSCRIBE THE PEAK/BUBBLE DUTY ASSIGNMENTS ON THE WHITE BOARD IN THE PEAK.
- E.** ASSIGN THE FIRST PERSON ON PEAK DUTY TO CHECK PEAK OXYGEN AND TRAUMA PACKS FOR ADEQUATE EQUIPMENT.
- F.** ON SATURDAY, HAVE THE TWO (2) FIRST TRACKS PATROLLERS CHECK THE SLEDS AT THE TOP OF 2/3 AND AT THE MID-STATION 2/3. ASSIGN THE FIRST PATROLLER IN FOR REGULAR DUTY TO CHECK THE SLEDS AT THE TOP OF 5. ASSIGN REMAINING SLEDS AS PATROLLERS ARRIVE.
- G.** THE TWO (2) FIRST TRACKS PATROLLERS MAY LEAVE AT 3:30 PM ON SATURDAY. (Unless there is a shortage of patrollers and there is a need for them to stay.)
- H.** ASSIGN PATROLLERS TO CHECK OUT THE "MOST DIFFICULT" SLOPES THAT ARE OPEN FOR ANY SAFETY HAZZARDS

I. ASSIGN PATROLLERS TO CHECK ALL SLEDS ON THE HILL TO ENSURE THAT THE SLEDS ON THE HILL ARE IN PLACE AND PROPERLY EQUIPPED (SEE LIST ON EACH SLED DOOR FOR CONTENTS)

J. HILL LEADER MUST CARRY A RADIO. MAKE SURE ALL RADIOS ARE DISTRIBUTED AND THE RADIO NUMBER IS ENTERED ON THE SIGN-IN SHEET - ASSIGNED PATROLLERS SHOULD RECEIVE RADIOS FIRST, THEN AUXILIARIES AND 2ND YEAR CANDIDATES. IF A PATROLLER ARRIVES AND A CANDIDATE HAS A RADIO, THEY SHOULD TURN THEIR RADIO OVER TO THE ARRIVING PATROLLER.

K. IF MOUNTAIN-OWNED PATROL RADIOS ARE BEING USED, BE SURE TO HAVE THEM RETURNED TO THE CHARGING STATIONS AT THE BASE AT 3:00 P.M. ON SATURDAY SO THEY ARE CHARGED FOR NIGHT SKIING.

L. CHECK WITH PAID PATROLLER IN CHARGE TO SEE WHAT NEEDS TO BE DONE IN THE MORNING AND MAINTAIN CONTACT THROUGHOUT DAY WHENEVER NECESSARY TO HELP THE OPERATION RUN SMOOTHLY.

M. VERIFY THAT ALL PATROLLERS HAVE SIGNED OUT AT THE END OF EACH DAY.

II. SUNDAY - DUTIES IN ADDITION TO ABOVE

A. FOR SUNDAY SWEEP, THERE ARE 2 PAID PATROLLERS AND 2 VOLUNTEER PATROLLERS ASSIGNED TO STAY UNTIL THE FINAL SWEEP ON SUNDAY.

B. NORTH CAMP SWEEP STARTS AT 4:30 P.M. -

1. ASSIGN FOUR PATROLLERS TO MEET AT THE TOP OF LIFT 7 AT 4:15 PM. ASSIGN ONE PATROLLER TO CLOSE THE TOP OF BACKBONE PASS AND LITTLE DIPPER. THAT PATROLLER WILL SWEEP BACKBONE PASS AND LOOK OVER SLIDER, LOGGER'S WAY AND LITTLE DIPPER. AT THE BOTTOM OF 6 PULL THE ROPE ACROSS BIG DIPPER BEFORE SWEEPING IT.

2. PATROLLERS AT THE TOP OF LIFT 7 WILL PREPARE THE TOBOGGANS FOR THE EVENING and move them inside the bubble for overnight storage, AT 4:30 ONE PATROLLER WILL BE DISPATCHED TO EACH TRAIL - ACE'S RUN, WHIP SAW, AND OVER THE EDGE. THE REMAINING PATROLLER WILL STAY NEAR THE TOP ADVISING GUESTS TO GO DOWN RIDGE RUN AND BOARD LIFT 6.

3. ONCE ALL FOUR PATROLLERS MEET AT THE BOTTOM OF LIFT 7, THEY WILL BOARD AND INFORM THE LIFT OPERATORS THEY ARE THE LAST ON. FROM THE TOP THEY WILL SWEEP RIDGE RUN, GATHERING THE OTHER PATROLLER ON THEIR WAY TO THE BOTTOM OF LIFT 6. AS PATROLLERS RIDE TO THE TOP OF THE MOUNTAIN, THEY WILL VISUALLY SWEEP BACKBONE PASS, SLIDER, LOGGER'S WAY, AND LITTLE DIPPER.

C. EAST RIDGE SWEEP STARTS AT 4:45 P.M. -

1. THE 2 VOLUNTEER PATROLLERS ASSIGNED TO STAY UNTIL SWEEP WILL BE PART OF THE EAST RIDGE SWEEP.

2. ASSIGN 1 PATROLLER TO STAND AT THE TOP OF LIFT 5 TO DIRECT ALL PATRONS TO BOARD LIFT 4.

3. IF AVAILABLE, ASSIGN A PATROLLER TO SWEEP MAINSTREET ON SKIS. IF NOT, MAINSTREET CAN BE SWEEPED FROM THE CHAIRLIFT BY THE OTHER EAST RIDGE PATROLLERS ON SWEEP.

4. ASSIGN ONE PATROLLER TO SWEEP, EYE OPENER, ODENS CHUTE/DOWN UNDER, AND MUSKRAT/DOWN UNDER. THE PATROLLER ASSIGNED TO MUSKRAT/DOWN UNDER SHOULD STOP AND PULL THE BANNERS ACROSS THE INTERSECTION OF BOULDER/DOWN UNDER LEAVING AN OVER-LAPPED GAP FOR A SNOWMOBILE TO GET THROUGH THE CENTER. CONTINUE SWEEPING DOWN UNDER TO MEET THE PATROLLER FROM ODENS CHUTE AT THE ODENS CHUTE/DOWN UNDER INTERSECTION.

5. ONCE ALL EAST RIDGE PATROLLERS MEET AT THE BOTTOM OF LIFT 5, THEY WILL BOARD AND INFORM THE LIFT OPERATORS THEY ARE THE LAST ON.

D. FRONT SIDE SWEEP STARTS AT 5 P.M. -

1. ASSIGN 2 PATROLLERS TO CLOSE CHAIR I AND CHAIR II OR III AT 5:00 P.M. THOSE 2 PATROLLERS MAY LEAVE ONCE THEY REACH THE TOP.

2. OF THE 2 VOLUNTEER PATROLLERS ASSIGNED TO STAY FOR SWEEP, 1 WILL SWEEP THE FACE AND ONE WILL SWEEP SQUIRREL CAGE. CHAIR 1 WILL BE OPEN UNTIL 5:25PM AND WAITING TO TAKE THE SWEEP PATROLLERS BACK TO THE TOP. IF SWEEP IS NOT COMPLETE UNTIL AFTER 5:25PM, THE PAID PATROLLERS ON SNOWMOBILES WILL MEET THEM AT THE BOTTOM AND BRING THEM TO THE BULL PEN WHERE THEY WILL TURN IN THEIR RADIOS AND SIGN OUT.

E. MAKE SURE THE BULL PEN & PEAK ARE CLEAN AT THE END OF EACH SHIFT.
